



Curtis Park Swim Team 2020 Policies Acknowledgement Form

Volunteer Obligations:

- All families are required to work at swim meets. Swimmers will not be allowed to participate in meets if the volunteer obligations are not met.
- We will be using SignUp Genius to sign up for volunteer positions at our home and away meets. The signup will be available the first week of June.
- Families working in trained positions (referee, stroke and turn, starter, head timer, clerk of course, and data entry) must work no less than 3 sessions (session = half of a meet), plus the Championships, if your child participates in the Championships. Dates for training opportunities with RSL will be announced as they become available.
- Families working in all other untrained positions are required to work no less than 4 sessions (session = half of a meet), plus the Championships, if your child participates.

Concessions Donations:

- To defray some of the costs and time commitment of concessions, we are requiring all families to pay a one-time \$40 fee in lieu of bringing food or drink donations to concessions.

New Swimmers/Age Group Caps:

- Each age group/gender is capped, with the following exception: If a new family registers their swimmers and some swimmers fall into an age group that is already filled, we will accept the swimmers in the capped group on a conditional basis. The swimmer may participate in all swim practices, but will only be eligible to swim in meets if other swimmers in that age group are not participating. Please note that this policy is designed to allow all family members to participate to the extent possible. If your family falls into this category and one of your swimmers cannot swim in meets, please understand the board and coaches will not entertain complaints.

Refund Policy:

- Refunds will be issued within the first 2 weeks from the start of practices to *new swimmers only*.
- Prorated refunds will be issued to any swimmer *for valid medical reasons only*.

Meet Sign-ups/Championships:

- Families **MUST** sign their swimmers up to participate in meets. The Signups for meets will be available through SignUp Genius. Signups will close *several* days before a meet date to enable the coaches to know who is swimming and seed the meet. **DO NOT** contact coaches or board members on a last minute basis asking to be added to a meet.
- We have a limited number of entries for RSL Battlefield Division Championships and there is a chance that not all swimmers will be selected to swim at the Championships. Please ensure that your swimmers know this in advance. If you want your swimmer to be considered for the Championships, please sign your swimmer in for this meet no later than Friday, July 19, 2019. *Once the Championships are seeded no changes can be made.* If a family has no swimmers participating in the Championships, they will not be expected to work at the Championships. All families with swimmers participating in the Championships, **MUST** volunteer (this is in addition to the 3 and 4 session requirements noted above).
